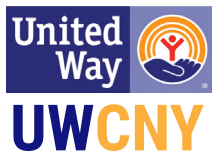

- Funded programs serve nearly 500 meals daily
- UWCNY funds 4 local food programs helping 2,643 individuals per day in Onondaga County
- \$52 will provide the program support and food for 10 meals

UNITED we improve children's education and development

Education is a pathway out of poverty.

- UWCNY funds 14 local programs focused on helping students succeed in school
- Last year 4,282 children were helped
- \$250 will give a child 7 weeks of academic assistance

Health programs cover a broad range of issues from mental health, to keeping families together, to preventing drug overdoses.

- 1,274 families were helped through family preservation programs last year
- \$1,000 provides 14 individuals with mental health services for a month

The Early Childhood Alliance is working to achieve the goal of having *all* young children in Onondaga County be healthy, thriving and successful in school and life.

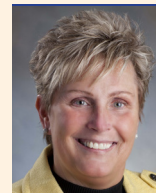
